



## BMW M Town Experience – COVID 19 Information

The safety of our customers and staff is our top priority. To ensure we can host this event safely we will follow all public health guidance and comply with current Government regulations. The below will be communicated to all guests prior to event day.

BMW M Town experience will proceed under [alert level 1](#), and [alert level 2](#). If Auckland is operating under [alert levels 3 or 4](#), the event will be cancelled. In the event that BMW M Town is cancelled, we will look at a suitable date to reschedule. Dealers and customers will also have the option to be refunded for the entire ticket price. Please refer to the cancellation policy in our [terms and conditions](#) for more information.

### How will the event operate under alert level 2?

The following measures will be implemented to minimise the participant's risk of exposure to Covid-19:

- Participant's experiences cold and flu like symptoms will be unable to take place in the event.
- Participants will be limited to small groups of 10 or less.
- Organisers and participants to practise physical distancing per Government requirements.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the event for participant use.
- Any shared spaces are cleaned regularly.
- Customers and guests will be required to sign in on arrival for contact tracing measures.

### How will the event operate under Alert Level 1?

The following measures will be implemented to minimise the participant's risk of exposure to Covid-19:

- Participants experiencing cold and flu like symptoms will be unable to take place in the event.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the event for participant use.
- Any shared spaces are cleaned regularly.
- Customers and guests will be required to sign in on arrival for contract training measures

### What happens if I am feeling unwell on the day?

Participants will not be able to take part in the event if they are experiencing any cold and flu like symptoms.

- A high temperature. (At least 38C)
- Coughing, Sneezing
- Sore throat
- Breathing problems
- Shortness of breath

If you or any of your family members have been in contact with someone who is in the process of being tested or has tested positive for Covid-19, we kindly ask you to stay home. Please let us know and we advise what your options are.
